We will be holding a series of Race for Life events on **Friday 8th July 2016**, children are welcome to wear non-uniform on this day (the theme being pink or blue). The KS1 race will be on our school field between 9.00-9.30am and parents are invited to come and watch. The KS2 race will be on the Helston Community College field next to the Fire Station, from 1.30pm-2.30pm, parents are also welcome to come and watch and collect their children at the end. Children and staff will run or walk for half an hour, challenging themselves to go as far as possible.
