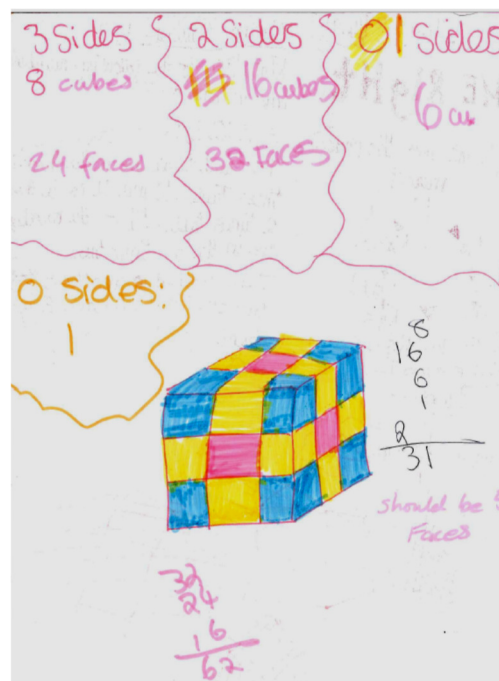
The expected percentage attendance for a child is 96%. Lets see if each class can aim for this or above!
