### Cober Valley Rotary Club - Time Capsule

The latest project of the Cober Valley Rotary Club in Helston involves burying a 50 year time capsule that will be opened in 2067. It is planned to have in it the thoughts and memories of local people in the form of messages and images for their future generations to read and see. £5 will buy a space in the capsule for an A4 envelope up to 12mm thick. It is hoped that up to 1,000 envelopes will be buried! The envelopes will be available up to 1st July 2017. They should be returned to the purchase point or any club member by this date. In partnership with the National Trust the capsule will be buried in the Penrose Estate in September 2017. Its location will be marked with a plaque.

We asked Sam from year 5 to tell us which activities virtue?
