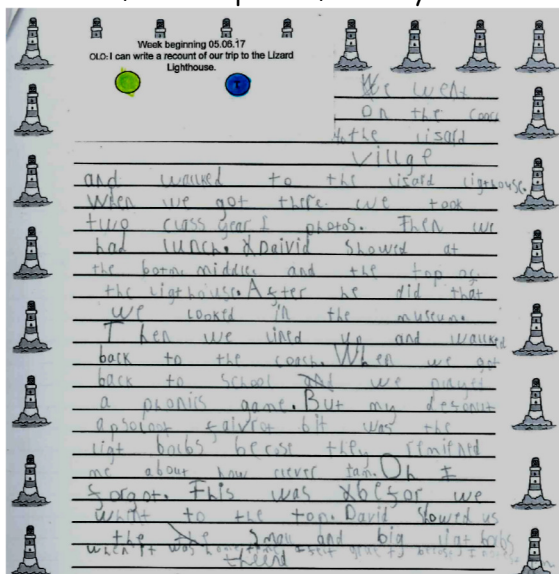
## Transition Arrangements
