#### Countywide School Keep Clear Markings

Cormac Solutions, on behalf of Cornwall Council, have reviewed primary and secondary schools in Cornwall and Parc Eglos School have been identified to have the existing School Keep Clear markings formalised by:

- Erecting signs and posts to prohibit vehicles stopping or waiting on the markings at any time
- Removing and refreshing the existing School Keep Clear markings to conform to regulations.
