### **Operation Encompass**

The school has been given the opportunity to take part in a project that will run jointly between school and Devon and Cornwall Police. Operation Encompass is the reporting to schools, prior to the start of the next school day, when a child or young person has been exposed to, or involved in, any domestic incident. Operation Encompass will ensure that a member of the school staff, known as a Key Adult, is trained to allow them to liaise with the police and to use the information that has been shared, in confidence, while ensuring that the school is able to make provision for possible difficulties experienced by children, or their families, who have been involved in, or exposed to, a domestic abusive incident. We are keen to offer the best support possible to all our pupils and we believe this will be extremely beneficial for all those involved.

### Parent Teacher Meetings—W/C 6th November 2017

All parents/carers will be invited to meet with their child's class teacher after half term to set their targets. As in previous years, you will be invited to sign up for a meeting after school in the week beginning 6th November (the 2nd week back after half term).

We are changing the way we set targets for children with individual needs. If your child used to have an IEP we will now be creating a 'Learning Passport' and you will be invited to a separate meeting to explain and put this together. You will not need to sign up for a meeting with your child's class teacher as well as this Learning Passport meeting. Please wait to receive further correspondence. Thank you.
