Week 1: Health and Wellbeing Update - Promoting Physical Activity and Wellbeing of Our Children

Studies show that children who are physically active are happier and more confident - they also achieve better academically!

As many parents may be aware from the news, guidance from the Chief Medical Officer is that all children and young people aged 5 to 18 should engage in at least 60 minutes of physical activity per day (of which 30 minutes of this should be in school). Whilst we are sure that many of our children do engage in 30 minutes or more at school each day, we are currently looking for more opportunities to ensure that ALL of our children engage in more physical activity.

This term we are going to be introducing the 'Daily Dash', as well as children-led daily warm up/activity blasts. We are also looking at holding alternative PE days so that children can take part in a wider range of sport.

For the Daily Dash, we would request that parents ensure that children have trainers/plimsolls in school with them each day.

As part of the promotion of physical activity, we will be providing regular information/updates for parents, sharing ideas as to how parents can help their children to be more active.

Celebration of Work

I am so proud with how everybody excelled in Monday morning's maths. I asked all children to consider this:



I asked them to <u>deduce</u> how many cubes (N) would be in the 100th case—and many of them found the correct answer! Lucy and Olivia went onto deduce the formula needed to calculate the number of cubes (N) for <u>any</u> case number (C)

$$(C+1)^2 = N$$

They also worked out the inverse to calculate the exact case number <u>from</u> the number of cubes (N):

$$(\int N) -1 = C$$
